## **TOPIC:** Selecting an Area (Location Management)

Location Management: Selecting an Area

Use this to choose a large area that your field work will be located in if one does not already exist. This should be a large area such as a county or a designated refuge. Only PIs or selected lab managers will have access to this.

- 1. On your Dashboard, click on the Settings tab on the left
- 2. Select Locations
- 3. Select +Add new area
- 4. Scroll the map to your area
- 5. Zoom in so that your entire research area is encompassed
  - a. If there already exists an area that as most of your site in it, you can edit the existing area to include your sites.
- 6. Name the area with something that is a clear identifier
  - a. Use "Palm Beach County" instead of "northern research site"
  - b. Any project can use this area so name it something that will make sense to everyone, not just to your project.
